While we continue to cherish and acknowledge the involvement of our loyal long time organizational base such as VNA, League of Women Voters, Falmouth Historical Society, Audible Local Ledger, Falmouth Democratic Committee, Falmouth Veterans, Cape & Islands Area Ballroom Dancing Association, numerous town committees/departments and more, we also made new alliances and welcome those into our fold. A few of our new or returning organizations include; The Falmouth Chamber of Commerce now under the direction of Christine Ross, Cape Cod Curling Club, Jewish Federation of Cape Cod, TRIAD and Falmouth's Promise under the direction of Dave Vieira. FCTV enjoys the involvement of fifty-two member organizations and government entities and provides services to hundreds more who use the channel 13 community bulletin board. We are also fortunate to enjoy the involvement and support of our two State Representatives. Representative Eric Turkington and Representative Matt Patrick both of whom have regular programs on FCTV and often appear on other shows like Report from Beacon Hill.

As we entered mid-year, our members spoke eloquently at the Governor's Cable Study Commission Hearing on July 2 clearly and staunchly heading off a state legislative issue that could have had potentially disastrous results for FCTV and community television in Massachusetts. Thanks in part to our members and with the steadfast support of Representative Matt Patrick, community television facilities like FCTV have been spared this loss of funding.

Our local business community continued their staunch support of FCTV and Town Meeting by underwriting Town Meeting Live at an unprecedented level, our members and supporters gave generously and we held two special fundraisers, a Hair-cut-a-thon sponsored by Hotlocks Salon and a pizza night at Papa Gino's.

It's not just about TV anymore as we commit ourselves to further becoming Falmouth's Community Communication Center. Thanks to our volunteers, we offer a variety of services in addition to the video production training and airing of programs on our local channel. These services include a computer learning center, community art gallery, web site and electronic bulletin board. Our SeniorNet Computer Learning Center, under the direction of JoAnn Fishbein and Bill Long along with the assistance of numerous volunteer instructors and coaches has grown and flourished with year round computer classes offering?? different classes in everything from fundamentals of computing to genealogy and word processing. The Maser Gallery, coordinated by Mark Chester had a full year with 12 shows featuring the work of sixteen upper cape artists. Chuck Bacon continues to serve as our volunteer Webmaster and Caroline Bacon as our Channel 13 bulletin board volunteer. To these and all who volunteer at FCTV we say thank you.

As each year goes by, we can see the remarkable impact FCTV and its volunteers have on our community. Topics of importance to our community are discussed and debated on FCTV, information is shared, lessons taught, music heard and sports watched. Thanks to our members and supporters, we grow, offer better and more equipment, impact our community, serve seniors, children, pets and each other. For your enthusiasm and support, we thank you and look forward to bringing more programming and better services to our community.

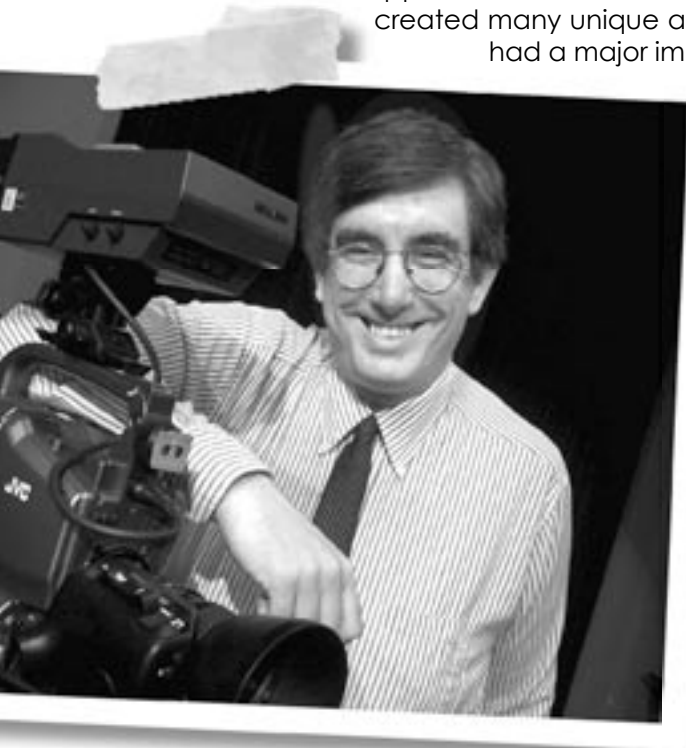






## Programming in 2003

**Local** viewers sampled a wide variety of people, places and topics in 2003 on Falmouth Community Television. Travelogues, documentaries, lectures, music, sports, game shows, political and children's programming filled the Channel 13 line up throughout the year. Our members approached these and a vast array of other topics with great gusto. FCTV Producers created many unique and interesting shows which served the greater needs of and had a major impact our community. As our members become more familiar with our digital equipment, we find the quality of our local programs to be drastically improved..



With over twelve hundred hours of brand new, first time programming on the channel, FCTV Producers worked at an astonishing pace. In comparing a two year period, from 2002 to 2003, we saw an increase of over 100 hours of new locally produced programs.

Environmental, scientific, political and community needs were just a few of topics that producers delved into on their studio shows. For our members, being in the studio did not mean being isolated from the outside world. Utilizing photographs, digital images, special effects, and location footage, our members brought the outside world home to Falmouth .

Our Field Producers took us near and far from Woods Hole to the Pacific Islands back to Falmouth Public Library and beyond. They highlighted exceptional people and distinct locations. They told stories in fresh exciting ways and created memorable moments.

## *FCTV Training & Classes*

Falmouth Community Television's training courses and workshops in 2003 were diverse and highlighted the advanced technology now available at FCTV. New equipment and courses were integrated into the station's existing infrastructure and, when necessary, new courses or workshops were created to fill special needs.

A total of twelve field production classes were held this past year, of these, six taught basic skills and six advanced skills. New digital camcorders were used in conjunction with the station's existing analog camcorders to provide members with a broader base of knowledge. Seven GL Camcorder courses were also taught to previously certified field one students so as to further enhance their production skills and give them the option to shoot in either digital or analog.

The past year continued to be transitional combining existing technologies with new complimentary ones side by side. Twenty three Screenplay and thirty five Final Cut Pro courses were taught throughout the year to offer members different methods of non-linear editing from two vastly different technological platforms. Additional workshops on software supporting Final Cut Pro were also offered, like Photoshop and After Effects, so that advanced editors could best exploit their new skills.

Specialized workshops and training camps were emphasized in 2003. The Woods Hole Film Festival Workshops netted 72 participants. The FCTV Kids Video Summer Camp proved ever more successful due to the addition of a second week of camp. Several children who attended our camp the previous year returned and were joined by several new participants. Youth were also empowered through a special studio camera certification course created so that they could be trained quickly and effectively to work on their own teen topic oriented series as camera operators.



Falmouth Community Television continues to strive for better training within a vast spectrum of methods and technologies. Our members continue to reap the benefits of our highly advanced facility and create astounding creative and varied programming with their new skills.

## SeniorNet

*"SENIORNET offers 10 different classes and 8 different workshops on a rotating basis."*

The SeniorNet Learning Center of Falmouth will complete its third year of operation this summer. This past year 30 classes and 16 workshops were held, enrolling over 165 students. New workshops on the following topics were among those offered: **Creating Mailing Labels, Keyboarding Shortcuts, Bargain Hunting on the Internet** and **Scanning**. This January the computers were updated to Windows XP and the hard drive of 2 computers were replaced. To date, 5 of the 6 computers have required new hard drives. The rising costs of computer maintenance and classroom materials necessitated an increase in course fees by \$5 to \$25 for an eight hour course and for to \$10 for a two hour workshop.

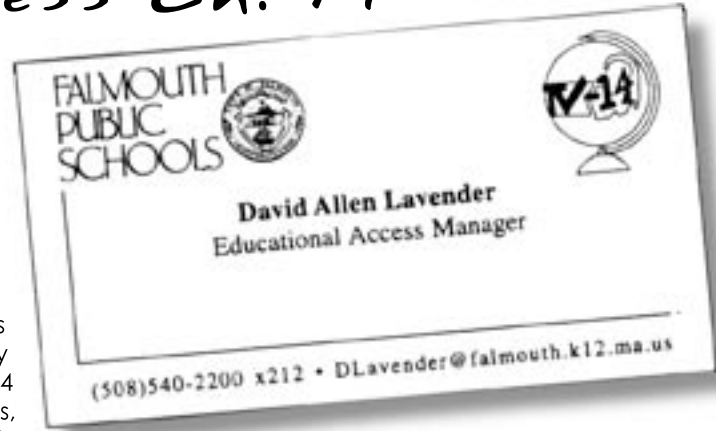
# Educational Access Ch. 14

During Educational Access Channel TV-14's second full year of operation, viewers were treated to a total of 75 locally produced programs. Featured were a complete variety of curricula-based, informational, educational and entertainment programming produced not only by the station manager, but by students, volunteers and faculty as well!

Locally originated programming is now featured seven days per week: Monday Thru Friday 7-9pm (often later), Saturday mornings 9-11am, and Sunday evenings 7-9:30pm. The TV-14 Bulletin Board, listing campus-wide event schedules, sports, lunch menus and the complete TV-14 Broadcast Schedule airs daily for a total of 11 hours.

Highlights of the 2003 season included the return of TV-14's wayward safari guide "Nigel" in "Mullen-Hall Family Math Nite" and "The Nigel Files: Mullen-Hall Reloaded." The character of Nigel has become a surprise hit with k-4 students and adults alike, and appears at least once per semester.

As TV-14's popularity in the Falmouth Community continues to grow, equipment and facilities upgrades are planned, more series programming is in the works, and an expanded primetime schedule is anticipated.
