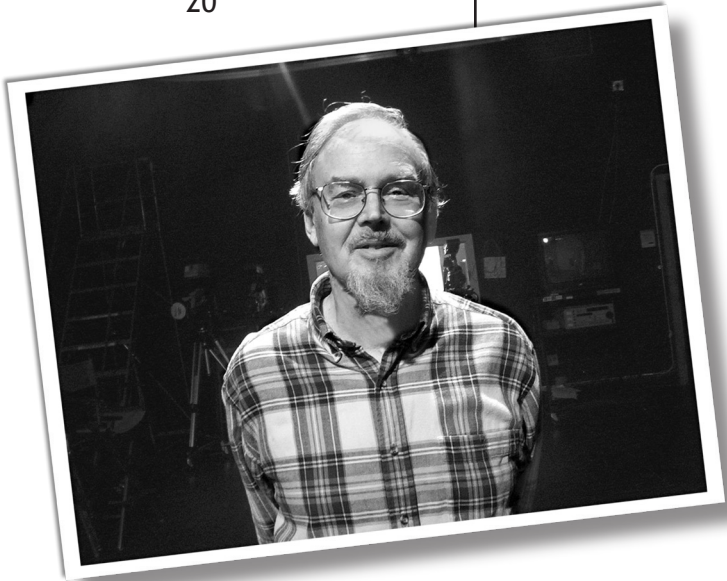
# mission statement

# educational access ch. 14

Thanks largely to increasing student and faculty participation, TV-14 continues to grow and provide the Falmouth Community with quality educational and curricula based programming, produced both nationally and locally. Among the highlights of the winter/spring 2004 season included **student produced programs** including the annual *Lawrence Winter Blast*, *Elementary Schools Track Meet*, *Falmouth Schools Science Fair and Class of 2007 Freshman Class Show*. **Student videographers** were also featured in *The Nigel Files*, *Morse Pond Follies*, *FHS Graduation*, first-time coverage of *FHS Senior Follies* and last summer's *Falmouth YC Regatta* and *Classic Wheels*.



Production of the new TV-14 series *Story-Time*, featuring the works of local children's authors, began in late May and premiered with enthusiastic response the first week of September. Program hosts/readers thus far have included Mullen-Hall's Maggi Yates, and East Falmouth's Marsha Zafiriou and Kathy Botelho. All-new faculty co-produced episodes of *Animation Alive* and *Book and Author* were also among the fall 2004 Schedule, as were *Dr. Hinkle's Physics at Falmouth*, an all-new *Best Friends*, System-Wide *Family Math & Science Nights*, and complete holiday event coverage (10 programs in all!) Capping it all off was the first time *live and student directed* broadcast of *FHS Holiday Concert*.

After eleven years of operation, FCTV leaves its childhood and enters adolescence. Not that we left the kids behind. In fact, 2004 saw more young people in our facility then ever before. Our **Summer Youth Program** kicked off with a revamped curriculum to include *Digital Storytelling*, David Vieira brought us *Falmouth Promise*, a wonderful group of kids who used FCTV to talk about issues effecting our society; the Maser Gallery welcomed, for the second year, **Falmouth Public School** students in grades K-12 who exhibited 2-Dimensional artwork; and **FCTV's summer high school and college interns** took us for a Blackhawk helicopter ride around Cape Cod and into Gillette Stadium where they interviewed Bob Kraft, owner of the New England Patriots.



The culture of a community is proportional to its citizens. This year our community took on new meaning as we welcomed friends from the **Wampanoag Tribe**. Together we traveled to their Annual Powwow, giving us significant appreciation for the culture of our Native American neighbors. **Eugenie Kuffler** taught us about Cuban culture through her Ethno Poetry, we traveled to Greece with **Barbara Peri**, **Merletta Martin** invited us to enjoy Black History Month lectures and Brian Bodio took us on a spiritual journey through his Psychology and Faith program. We continued current collaborations and welcomed new partners representing a variety of constituents throughout Falmouth including **Falmouth Cultural Alliance**, **Falmouth Historical Society**, **Falmouth Chamber of Commerce**, **Toastmasters**, **Falmouth Democratic Committee**, **TRIAD**, **Commodores**, **VNA**, **Cape Cod Curling Club** and the **Town Band** to name just a few.

Our own FCTV community shifted as we bade farewell to two associates. Frank Meroney, our wonderful technician, moved to Los Angeles to advance his career in the field of set construction, followed by long time operations manager and friend Russ Hannagan who left to become Executive Director of East Bridgewater Community Television. We miss them and wish them all the best. *To ease our loss we were fortunate to welcome Technician Andy Despres and Operations Manager David Finer.*

Equipment was upgraded to keep us start-of-the-art. A gray curtain in Studio A gave productions a new updated look, computer editing was expanded with the addition of two Apple G5 computers and we began the process of changing playback from tape based to a digital hard drive based system. Encoding equipment was purchased so that our producers could save their programs as files which could be cablecast.

In other 2004 highlights, we implemented a Summer Lecture series featuring professionals in the field of television. The program kicked off with Air Force News Tsgt. Bill Scherer and former WBZ producer and host Barbara Brilliant. FCTV was recognized regionally and nationally when Frank and Jason won first place in the Northeast Region Video Festival for their Public Service Announcement on community television and Kevin King was awarded first place for his documentary on drinking water in Falmouth.

As we continue to grow and welcome new communities and cultures within our FCTV community, we thank all of you who made 2004 a success. We thank you for your time, creativity, generosity and commitment. Most of all, we thank you for using FCTV to make Falmouth a better place to live.

# programming & training

## A Time of Growth

David Finer, Training & Operations Mgr.

Well, 2004 was quite the year for FCTV. It was a year of change, a year of growth, a year in which we started using non-tape formats for cablecast.

First and foremost, my predecessor Russ Hannagan left FCTV in September to take on the challenge of Executive Director at East Bridgewater Community Television. Russ was here for over six years and we'd like to thank him for all he did for FCTV (and all that he continues to do). I joined the team in October and thank everyone (staff and volunteers alike) for the reception I have received so far. My transition to Falmouth has been seamless.



With over thirteen hundred hours of brand new local programming in 2004, you could say that the producers of Falmouth Community Television have been quite busy. From government meetings to parades, religious programming to sports, politics to senior issues and documentaries to game shows, *FCTV had a wide range of shows throughout the year. Between brand new programs and repeats, our channel cablecast over 5,000 hours of programming.*

As the technology has changed at FCTV, so too have the members to keep up with the times. Members are opting for the newer digital cameras and learning to use the non-linear editing suites. More than 50 people have been trained in these new technologies with many more to come in the future. At the same time, we anticipate more people are walking in the doors of FCTV

for the first time and are still signing up for basic studio and basic field production classes. *In 2004, we offered 70 different classes and trained almost 190 members in various forms of television production.*

As we move forward into 2005, FCTV will be announcing new ways for shows to air on Channel 13 and offering classes for all members to keep up with the times. Life here on Dillingham Ave. is moving quite quickly these days. If you stop for just a moment, you might just miss it.

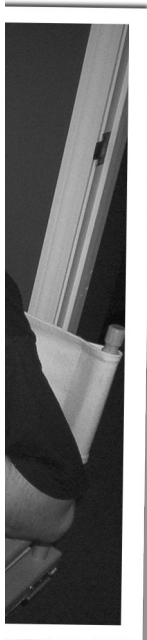
