## letter from the E.D.

#### 2005, A YEAR IN REVIEW

Debra Rogers, Executive Director

As we close out 2005, FCTV completes its twelfth-year of operation and looks to the future. Potential federal legislation, which could have negatively impacted funding for community media, gave us quite a scare for a while but we were able to assist in overcoming this while continuing to find ways of increasing our earned income and further venturing into the digital age.

In 2005, thanks to Technician Andy Despres, FCTV began live streaming of channel 13 on the Internet. Channel 13 can now be viewed by anyone, near or far. Never again will you miss a Selectmen's Meeting while traveling, as long as you have a computer and Internet connection. By logging onto FCTV's website, www.fctv.org, with just one click you are watching FCTV live with only a few second delay.



Another big transition was implementing a server based playback system, allowing us to cablecast video files as opposed to tapes or DVD's only. This has had a tremendously positive impact on the quality of the channel while also giving us the opportunity to cablecast more programming as we no longer have as many tape changes. This system, manufactured by Tightrope Media Systems, also has a bulletin board program, which can be accessed remotely via the Internet. This proved to be a critical resource during the winter storm of 2005 when roads became impassable. We were able to communicate directly with the Town of Falmouth Emergency Operations Center and update the community bulletin board with emergency information. After a short period of "working out the bugs," we have found this system invaluable as we partner with our town to become part of the Falmouth emergency communications system.

A difficult goodbye occurred in the summer of 2005. Jason Crow left to move to Cambridge and join the staff of CCTV. Jason brought to FCTV an extraordinary creativity and knowledge of Final Cut Pro and we will be forever grateful for his contributions. Fortunate for us, Derek Frates came on board as Production Coordinator. Derek has proven to be a wonderful resource to our members and brings with him infinite enthusiasm and energy. We also added a new staff position, Facility Assistant, and welcomed Laura Paulsen in late 2005. Laura is a welcome addition to our staff and is working at the reception desk and on promotion and special events.

Our producers continued to bring us creative and informative programming throughout 2005. We are extremely fortunate to have so many active, engaged producers who year after year bring us programming which highlights our community, educates our citizens and keeps us informed and engaged in the life of Falmouth. Music, lectures, community events, art, town and state government meetings and hearings, discussions and entertainment abounded. Government meetings, a vital programming

resource for our viewers continued to grace our channel thanks to an incredibly dedicated crew of volunteers who brought us Planning, Conservation and Zoning Board meetings, Budget Hearings, Coonamessett River Restoration Task Force and Falmouth Housing Trust meetings to name a few. FCTV also continued its commitment to producing the weekly Selectmen's Meetings and bi-annual Town Meeting. These important and valuable programs have also served to remind us of the need for an additional channel and so we are actively working with our municipal leaders toward opening up the government channel for video programming use.

Equipment upgrades included additions to the van, a Compix computer graphics system in Control Room A, computer for streaming channel 13, audio mixers, microphones, DVD recorders and a navy blue curtain for Studio A.

In other 2005 highlights, we partnered with the Cape Cod Conservatory, holding several youth media workshops including *KidsNews*, *Acting* and *Animation* classes. Thanks to Shirley Corvo we held a first ever (and highly successful) *Appraisal Fair* fundraising event. Participated in *Arts Alive* a community wide festival highlighting the arts in Falmouth. Established the FCTV *Advisory Council* and held a council breakfast meeting. Hosted the *Alliance For Community Media Northeast Region Spring Conference*. Survived the flood of 2005. Participated in the *Katharine Lee Bates Poetry Festival*. Working with CONNECT and Artsfalmouth welcomed the *CONNECT...with arts in Falmouth* program to our channel, a twice daily listing of cultural events happening in Falmouth which is promoted in hotels, motels and bed & breakfast establishments throughout Falmouth. Held twelve *gallery* exhibits throughout the year featuring the work of twelve local artists as well as numerous Falmouth Public Schools student artists. Continued our affiliated *SeniorNet Computer Learning Center* program offering seniors computer literacy classes ranging from fundamentals to advanced skills. Provided an ongoing curriculum of video production and post production classes and more!

Thanks to our volunteer producers, sponsors, supporters, staff, board of directors, town leaders and viewers it has been another great year at FCTV. Still, we will continue to seek ways to grow, engage our community and provide a thriving and valuable communications resource to the people of Falmouth. We invite everyone to come, get involved, create community-programming, view and exhibit in our Maser Art Gallery and take a class or teach a class in our SeniorNet Computer Learning Center. We strive to do better every year and we invite you all to come along and be a part of this wonderful community we call FCTV.


# programming & training

THE FUTURE IS NOW!

It's amazing that 2005 is already over. It's been a wonderful ride so far and I can not wait to see what the future has in store for the facility.

As most of you know, the TeraByte Server has been running since the end of 2004. At this point, about 40% of the programs you now see on the channel are actually coming from the server. If you watched FCTV in 2005, you saw a wide array of programs. We learned about everything from "The American Labor Movement" to the Falmouth Bike Path to cranberry farming. A few other shows featured were "Battle of the Bands," "Wicked Sports," and "Medicare Drug Program." We are grateful to all of our volunteer producers



for bringing us timely and interesting programs throughout 2005. Five of our producers garnered a large amount of feedback for their programs. Dick Batchelor's two-part "Moving House" program was one of the most talked about of the year. Pucky Roslansky came up with programs that ranged from coverage of Candidate's Night to footage of her trip to Morocco. Barbara Peri had multi-part specials on trips to both Costa Rica and Thailand. Kevin Lynch stayed busy with his reviews of town events (Road Race & Cranberry Festival) as well as travelogues from his vacations (Yellowstone). Fred Gitlitz presented documentary programs that ran the entire spectrum of historical topics. Whether it was a VHS tape, DVD or MPEG movie file, FCTV aired over 4,700 hours of programming in 2005.

Training during the year was as challenging as it was rewarding. With all of the new equipment here,

we spent a lot of time bringing our more seasoned producers up to speed - as well as training brand new producers. Production Coordinator Derek Frates trained a group of field producers and immediately had them working on Falmouth Commodores games as well as the Annual Falmouth Road Race. Also during the summer, I worked with the kids from the Cape Cod Conservatory. The show entitled "FCTV KidNews" was produced entirely by the students and highlighted some of their hidden talents. We also started to train members of non-profit groups and organizations on how to create their own community bulletin board pages. Through an internet connection, they can create and edit their own pages that appear on Channel 13. We take pride here at FCTV of not only the types of classes we offer, but the amount of classes we offer. Over the course of 2005, we trained 146 volunteers in 56 classes!

We here at FCTV are constantly trying to be at our best, so you can be at your best. Come join us on this amazing and fantastic ride over the next couple of years - I can guarantee that it's something you won't want to miss!

The SeniorNet Learning Center of Falmouth continues to provide low cost computer classes and workshops to the older adult population of Falmouth. Over the course of the year, the volunteer staff of SeniorNet has offered 27 classes and 15 workshops, addressing the needs of 180 students. As the skill level of students improves, we have begun offering more two hour workshops in addition to the basic classes. These workshops do not require SeniorNet membership. Additionally, an ongoing workshop, Family StoryTelling, was introduced. Students learn the art of digital storytelling in this weekly workshop. By adding narration and music to their photographs, participants create a 5-10 minute video to share with family and friends. This year also saw the addition of our first nonagenarian to the student roster - reminding us that you are never to old to learn something new.
