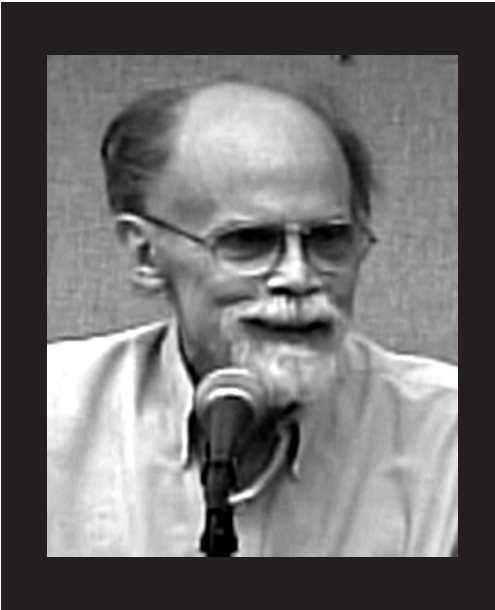

From the Executive Director Debra A. Rogers



As I was catching up on the newspaper this morning I noted once again an FCTV mention in a letter to the editor. It typically starts with “I was watching FCTV last night...” or “I was watching the meeting on FCTV today...”

It got me thinking again about the impact of local programming and what a key role FCTV plays in our community.

A significant measure of our success is due to the diligence and altruism of our volunteer producers in that there is very little of life in Falmouth that is not seen on FCTV. Election coverage, candidate forums, conservation programs, culture, sports, government meetings, literacy, pet adoption, political commentary, diversity education, community events, public affairs and more graced our channel this past year. We continue our commitment to municipal programming on FCTV with Fire, Police and Building Department programs, as well as the numerous town committee meetings, Selectmen and Town Meeting. FCTV staff and volunteers together covered major community events including Falmouth Road Race, Arts Alive, Falmouth Christmas Parade and the inaugural JazzFest Falmouth.

Our facility also continues to be used as a means of outreach with FCTV hosting the ArtsFalmouth winter networking event in February of 2008. This event provided an opportunity for those in the cultural community to tour FCTV, learn about community media and how they can get involved. We are a resource offering meeting space to community groups such as TRIAD, DAV #81, Falmouth VFW Post #2569, Independent Writers, Falmouth Reiki Clinic, Toastmasters, ArtsFalmouth, JazzFest and more.

Our collaboration with the Gus Canty Recreation Center and the FCTV Kids Video Club brought more youth into our facility and they, along with our college interns provided a new perspective with informative, entertaining and interesting programs.

Covering events and telling stories would not be possible without the tools to do so. Several equipment purchases were made in 2008 including; a Compix Laptop Character Generator to provide for professional graphics on multi-camera location productions, several lapel microphones, switchers for edit suites to allow for ease of equipment use, DVD Players, monitors and replacement headsets. A significant amount of our equipment funding was used to update cablecast equipment including the program server, switcher and adding a Compix character generator system to allow us to place graphics over video programming as a further means of providing our community emergency or timely information without program interruption.

As each year passes we seek to enhance our services and this past year was no exception. New workshops were added, as was a Final Cut Club. Our Kids Video Club became a more consistent presence in 2008. As you will read in this report we saw an increase in programming, workshops and participation this past year. The Maser Gallery continues to host first rate exhibits, the Computer Learning Center has a new name and updated workshops and thankfully even with a floundering economy we were able to conduct successful fundraising activities which kept us moving forward.

Thanks to our members, staff and Board of Directors, FCTV continues to grow while becoming an even more integral part of our community.

We are so grateful to all who participate in making FCTV a better place and look forward to what we can build together in the coming years.



Training and Programming



From Training and Operations Manager Anthony Sadera

The world of communication is constantly changing, and faster and faster each year, it seems. New trends appear each season. Some fade quickly as fads, some live to dazzle for a moment then ultimately fade, and few become almost essential parts of our daily lives. One common theme that runs through all successful trends is empowerment. FCTV and local access television have always been at the forefront of empowerment. As the means to communicate has become more and more available to more people, with everything from inexpensive cameras, editing software and publishing options like YouTube,

that hasn't diminished. In fact, it is more important than ever to have a resource for those wishing to communicate to have access to the training and media literacy to communicate effectively.

In 2008, we began a special software seminar series designed to demystify some of the newest tools of the trade. We found that a significant number of attendees, some who had never taken a workshop at a local access facility before, were looking to get much needed advice and information for projects they were working on at home, editing programs for Channel 13 with their own computers. Beginning this past year, we now offer both larger demonstration classes and one-on-one tutorial training in graphics software like LiveType, AfterEffects, Compix GenCG, Garage Band, and Photoshop, as well as the industry standard, Final Cut Pro, equipped in all of our edit suites.

These tools make post-production, formerly the bottleneck of most field on-location or documentary-style programs, easier and more efficient. This is one of the reasons we're seeing an increase in these types of programs on Channel 13, and an increase in our field training as well. Also, as video cameras become more and more affordable, people have found that field training on our GL cameras has benefited their work with their own cameras. Our studio classes offer principles of audio, lighting, directing and composition that are applicable to almost any production.

As the means of production becomes more and more accessible, the training and skills necessary to properly use it must also. Anyone can read a book or a manual, but the experience we offer, with hands-on learning, personal feedback and assistance, remains as unique as it was when we first started long before the internet revolution. While equipment and technology is constantly changing, the basic principles of effective communication do not. At FCTV, we continue to incorporate new technologies into our training offerings. But at the same time, the concepts and principles learned from our Studio and Field classes are just as important, if not more so. The face-to-face teamwork and feedback from like-minded people that you get from the FCTV experience is something that's hard to Google up on the fly.

Educational Access Channel 14

Falmouth Educational Access Channel (TV-14) has had an eventful year bringing Falmouth Public Schools content to its viewers. With the work of many individuals including TV-14’s new program manager, Ryan Webber; Nick Riebeselhl, a junior at Falmouth High School; Joe Studley; and other student volunteers; TV-14 continues to grow. A new bulletin board with updated graphics and featuring photos throughout Falmouth has been added and provides information such as programming schedules, FPS menus and events, and sports schedules. School committee meetings have resumed broadcasting live on Tuesday evenings, and are rebroadcast twice daily at 9AM and 7PM. Our lineup includes the informative Parent Connection Series featuring topics such as Internet safety, bullying, and attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder. Music, choral, and band concerts continue to be broadcast on a regular basis as well as the schools’ open house/meet the teacher nights. Tours showing the progress of construction at Falmouth High are now filmed on a monthly basis.

A new editing suite (dual display iMac with Final Cut Pro) has been set up at the Educational Access Channel office. An additional production camera has been added to allow for multi-camera shoots, and is supplemented with new tripod equipment and a wireless microphone system. Production equipment used for live school committee meetings (microphones, a 16-port soundboard, and a DVD capture deck) has also been added.

With the enthusiastic support of FCTV’s staff (including Debra Rogers), Interim Superintendent Marc Dupuis, and many others the Educational Access Channel continues to thrive.

The Computer Learning Center For Seniors

The SeniorNet Learning Center of Falmouth has taken on a new name and a new face. As of April 1, 2008 the SeniorNet Learning Center became the Computer Learning Center for Seniors of Upper Cape Cod (CLCS). This change was necessitated by a change in policy by the national SeniorNet organization which would have substantially increased the cost of our affiliation. To meet this increase we would have had to double the number of new members or increase course fees. We decided this was not a viable option given the size of our facility and our philosophy of keeping classes small and affordable to better serve our students.

Despite this change we continued to provide the same level of support and classes for our students. During 2008 there were 102 students in 21 different classes. The volunteer staff at the CLCS wrote new manuals for all classes.

The major benefit of this change is that all membership and course fees will remain local. The membership fee was reduced from \$40 to \$25 entitling individuals to representative membership in both CLCS and FCTV.

The Maser Gallery

It was another exciting year of local artistry at FCTV’s Maser Gallery. The Gallery has become a popular aspect of FCTV’s community presence. We continue to be fortunate to have the volunteer services of Photographer and Falmouth Resident Mark Chester as Maser Gallery Coordinator.
