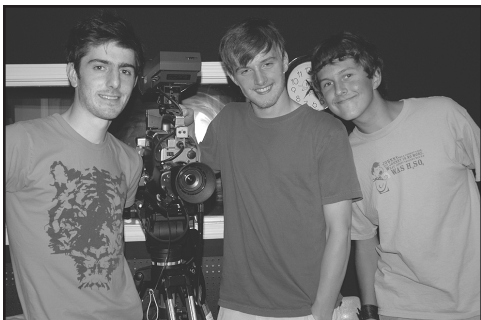

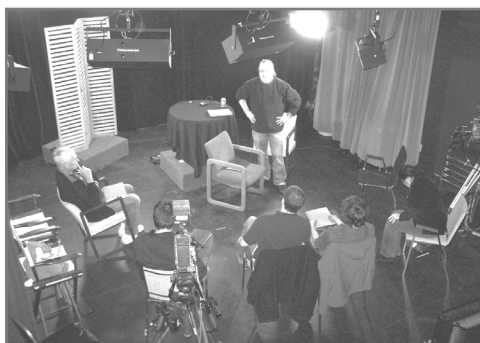

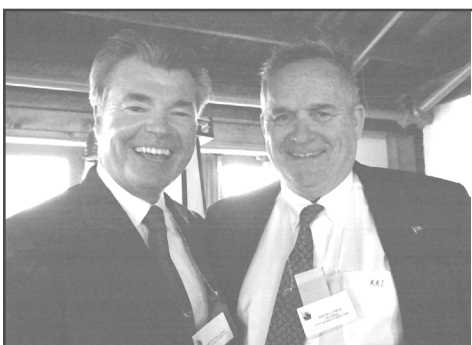

FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, DEBRA ROGERS



For over 18 years FCTV has continued to grow and meet the needs of our members and community as a whole. Our success is derived by the people who make up Falmouth Community Television. From board members to staff, member producers, supporters and viewers, our achievements come via the efforts of everyone who believes in community media and takes a step to put their own stamp on FCTV. It is our pleasure to present this annual report and highlight the accomplishments of 2009, some of which include:

- Renovate facility including new flooring and paint.
- Update equipment including the addition of a Broadcast Pix digital production switcher and graphics system, fluorescent studio lights, and flip cameras,
- Continue live streaming and begin offering video on demand.
- Provide youth oriented training in the form of workshops, camps and ongoing kids clubs, expanding regular club from one to two and offering summer and vacation programs for youth.
- Presentation of FCTV Summer Lecture Series featuring Plymouth Rock Studios (June), Filmmaker Beth Murphy (July) and Paul Desjarlais (August).
- Assist with Falmouth Music & Arts Pavilion dedication.
- Recognition by Falmouth Toastmasters of FCTV community impact.
- Hold first annual PSA Day to provide studio and production crew to Falmouth non-profit organizations.
- Promote FCTV at Falmouth Chamber of Commerce 'InfoMania.'
- Provide staff coverage of the Falmouth Road Race, Arts Alive, JazzFest, Falmouth Christmas Parade, Town Meeting and Selectmen Meetings while also coordinating volunteer coverage of several other government meetings and community events.
- Obtain grants from Google, Woods Hole Foundation, Falmouth Road Race, Cape Light Compact and Shaws Supermarket.
- Implement efforts to "go green."
- Attend and testify at state hearings to defeat efforts to enact state franchising.
- Work with town on new cable license.
- Offer twelve interesting and unique gallery shows.
- Provide new and enhanced training opportunities to 543 students in 137 classes.
- Hold several fundraisers throughout the year including a first time collaboration with Puritan Cape Cod.
- Partner with Falmouth Historical Society, Falmouth and Woods Hole Libraries on Mass Memories Road Show.
- Provide career opportunities to Falmouth youth.
- Continue ongoing collaborations with organizations and community groups including League of Women Voters, Falmouth Library, Falmouth Historical Society, Falmouth Chamber of Commerce, ArtsFalmouth (JazzFest) and more.
- Review procedures and implement new policies intended to provide enhanced oversight.
- Provide services to 626 members and untold viewers and supporters.
- Cablecast over 600 hours of first run, locally produced programming and almost 350 hours of first run member sponsored programming for a total of over 953 hours of first run programming in 2009.
- Provide computer literacy training to area seniors.

As I prepare this list I am truly amazed how quickly the year went, the efforts made and outcomes enjoyed. Once again, I ask that those reading this report take the time to look at the names of those who are FCTV and in particular the many spectacular programs we have enjoyed this past year. It is my hope that as each year passes we gain a better understanding of the needs of our community and that together we strive to find ways to meet those needs through community media.

PROGRAMMING AND TRAINING

From Director of Operations, Anthony Sadera

As any newcomer to our town quickly notices, Falmouth is a tight-knit community with a remarkable “sense of place.” People in Falmouth take great pride in their town: its beauty, its history, and its unique geography and natural resources. As I sit down to take a look back at the programming that the people of Falmouth have been able to view on Channel 13, that theme, that pride and commitment to maintaining the town’s quality of life comes through time and time again. It is the people of Falmouth that shape that programming in their contributions, efforts and commitment to Falmouth Community Television and we at FCTV feel fortunate to serve them.



For several years now, the people of Falmouth have relied on Falmouth Community Television to be its window into the workings of the town government through our live gavel-to-gavel coverage of every Selectmen’s Meeting and each Town Meeting. This past year, in fact, FCTV cablecast four Town Meetings, as the town faced financial challenges it has not seen in many years. In 2009, thanks to a core of very dedicated volunteer producers, Falmouth has also had access to live coverage of every Planning Board Meeting, Conservation Commission Meeting, and Zoning Board of Appeals Meeting. Leading up to every single local election. FCTV’s volunteer producers provided their fellow townspeople with an opportunity to see each candidate and hear their positions in a fair, unbiased setting, either through the many League of Women Voter’s forums or debates produced at our studios. In addition, we were grateful in 2009 to have several municipal leaders such as the Fire Chief, Police Chief, and Building Commissioner give our viewers an in-depth look at what they do and offer critical information to those they serve through their self-produced series programs.

But FCTV’s programming is so much more than that, and again, that “sense of place” and pride in our heritage, arts, science, sports and resources and an admirable commitment to volunteerism comes through continually. Our member producers, through their own initiative, treated the people of Falmouth to everything from the fascinating lectures offered by MIT and the MBL in Woods Hole to concert performances by the Falmouth Chorale and Town Band to baseball games featuring our own Cape Cod League team, the Falmouth Commodores. Live, call-in programs, from our own studios, such as Falmouth First and Sport Crunch among others, gave the viewers at home a chance to connect and offer their own opinions and observations. We were thrilled in 2009 when a comedy series, “Spooky House,” produced by a group of inventive and sharp-witted young adults here at FCTV won a prestigious national Hometown Award from the Alliance For Community Media. One of the most remarkable new additions to the programming schedule in 2009 is the live call-in game show, “Totally Trivia Junior,” produced, directed and crewed entirely by children from local schools. A core of future television producers and communicators is developing before our eyes at FCTV and getting invaluable lessons in media literacy along the way.

At FCTV we place a high priority in serving our members and our town by offering the best training and equipment possible. In 2009, in addition to our basic studio and field classes, we updated our training curriculum with more software seminars to demystify the 21st century’s state-of-the-arts means of production, including Final Cut Pro, Photoshop, LiveType, Compix GenCG and AfterEffects. “Your Video On The Internet” assists producers in using the Internet to get their programming out to the rest of the world. Our staff scheduled an increasing number of one-on-one tutorials this past year to offer hands-on training with Final Cut Pro and added regular Editing Concepts classes which cover the more timeless techniques that are applicable to all editing systems, a class that has been a benefit to members who are beginning to do much of their editing at home with various software systems. With our new studio upgrades, we’ve offered more advanced studio training to make the most of our fluorescent lighting system, Broadcast Pix Slate 1000 and Title Motion Pro. A renewed commitment to media literacy through our updated and improved children’s after school classes has already produced impressive results as we now have young people taking more control and responsibility over their own ability to communicate through the media of television.

It is our member base that drives our curriculum as much as it does our programming. While we continually introduce new hardware and software to enhance their productions, in many cases, they know what they need to learn and ask us to teach them. We are grateful to have so many members of our community that are driven to improve their skills and despite being ‘amateur’ productions the level of professionalism that is found in our member productions is impressive.

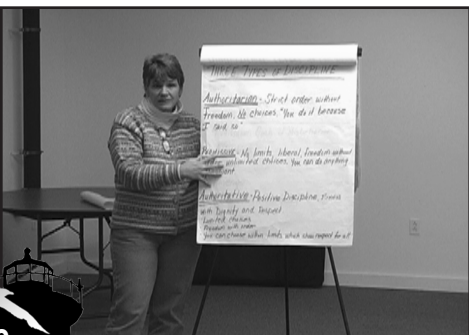

EDUCATIONAL ACCESS CHANNEL 14



Falmouth Educational Access Channel 14 (EdTV) has had an eventful year bringing Falmouth Public Schools content to its viewers. With the work of many individuals including EdTV's program manager, Ryan Webber; Nick Riebesehl, a junior at Falmouth High School; and many student/faculty/parent volunteers; EdTV continues to grow. In the 2008-2009 school year, over 120 locally produced shows and events were broadcast. School committee meetings continue to be shown live on Tuesday evenings, and are rebroadcast twice daily at 9AM and 7PM. Our lineup includes the informative Parent Connection Series featuring topics such as internet safety, teen drug abuse and attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder.

A new addition to programming is Morse Pond School's "Catapult!," headed by teacher Brian Switzer and produced for kids by kids. "Catapult!" focuses on a wide range of student skills, including reporting, acting, and sketch comedy and is shown daily at 4pm. Music, choral, and band concerts continue to be broadcast on a regular basis as well as the schools' open house and art shows. Tours showing the progress of construction at Falmouth High are filmed on a monthly basis.

A new Leightronix Nexus video server has dramatically improved EdTV's broadcast capabilities. Program scheduling is now automated and show playback is completely digitized - EdTV now broadcasts throughout the entire day. Snow

and school emergency closing notices are posted as a lower-thirds crawl as an additional ability with the Nexus and have been successfully used on several occasions this year. A new online program schedule can now be found on EdTV's website at

With the enthusiastic support of FCTV's staff (including Debra Rogers), Interim Superintendent Marc Dupuis, and many others the Educational Access Channel continues to thrive.
